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### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the officials from the Attorney General's Office, the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Economic Development, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, the Department of Higher Education and Workforce Development, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Mental Health, the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Corrections, the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, the Department of Revenue, the Department of Public Safety (Office of the Director, Capitol Police, Alcohol & Tobacco Control, Fire Safety, Gaming Commission, Missouri Highway Patrol, State Emergency Management Agency and Veterans Commission), the Missouri National Guard, the Department of Social Services, the Office of the Governor, the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules, the Joint Committee on Public Employee Retirement, the Missouri Lottery Commission, the Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Missouri Ethics Commission, the Missouri House of Representatives, the Department of Transportation, the Office of Prosecution Services, the Office of Administration, Administrative Hearing Commission, the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the Office of the State Auditor, the Missouri Senate, the Office of the Secretary of State, the Office of the State Public Defender and the State Tax Commission each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations for this proposal.

**Oversight** notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Agriculture** defer to the Office of Administration for the potential fiscal impact of this proposal.

Officials from the City of Kansas City and City of O'Fallon both assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the University of Central Missouri and University of Missouri System both assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **Marquand-Zion R VI** school district assume the proposal would have an impact on their respective organization. However, no additional information was provided.

**Oversight** does not anticipate a fiscal impact to local political subdivisions. However, Oversight received a limited number of responses from local political subdivisions related to the fiscal impact of this proposal. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information available. Upon the receipt of additional responses, Oversight will review to determine if an

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updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval to publish a new fiscal note.
