ASSUMPTION

§537.325 – Liability for equine activities

Officials from the **Office of Attorney General (AGO)** assume any potential litigation costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources. The AGO may seek additional appropriations if the proposal results in a significant increase in litigation or investigation costs.

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight assumes the AGO will be able to perform any additional duties required by this proposal with current staff and resources and will reflect no fiscal impact to the AGO for fiscal note purposes.

Officials from the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol, the Missouri Department of Agriculture, the Missouri Department of Conservation and the Missouri Office of Prosecution Services each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

In response to the previous version of this proposal, officials from the **Office of the State**Courts Administrator assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, various county officials were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
