FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of the State Courts Administrator (OSCA)** state that during the past five years there was an average of 955 circuit civil case filings, 3,276 domestic relations civil case filings and 5,559 associate civil and small claims civil case filings, for a total of **9,790 civil cases** filed in the 23rd judicial circuit.

The special surcharge amount of \$45.00 is estimated to increase funds for the courthouse construction fund \$0 to \$440,550 (\$45 x 9,790 cases) annually in addition to other court costs. All funds shall be payable to the clerk of the twenty-third judicial circuit.

Oversight assumes this proposal adds a surcharge of \$45 on civil circuit cases, in addition to all other court costs at the time of filing a suit and expires on August 28, 2045. Therefore, Oversight will reflect revenues of up to \$440,550 annually for this proposal.

Oversight notes the 23rd Judicial Circuit is for Jefferson County and OSCA has based their estimates using the following information below:

FISCAL IMPACT – Small Business

Small businesses filing civil cases in the 23rd Judicial Circuit would be negatively impacted by this proposal. (§488.448)

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill requires a party filing a civil case in the 23rd Judicial Circuit to pay a surcharge of \$45 at the time of filing suit. This does not apply to proceedings when costs are otherwise waived or paid.

The funds from this surcharge will be credited to a courthouse construction fund, to be used for the construction of a new courthouse for the 23rd Judicial Circuit.

The provisions of this bill will expire on August 28, 2045. (§488.448)

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
