# **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

§115.133 – Suffrage of Persons on Probation or Parole

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State (SOS)** and the **Department of Corrections** (**DOC**) each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

**Oversight** notes that as of March 10, 2025, there were 52,620 individuals under probation and parole supervision according to information provided from DOC. Therefore, there could be an increase in registered voters.

**Oversight** notes that the Office of the Secretary of State and Department of Corrections have each stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

In response to similar legislation, HB 847 (2025), officials from the **Kansas City Election Board** stated cleaning up their voter registration files and training their staff and deputy registrars the new procedures and re-printing materials may cost up to \$5000.

**Oversight** assumes Kansas City Election Board could absorb the costs related to this proposal with existing resources.

Officials from the St. Louis County Board of Elections, Jackson County Election Board, Platte County Board of Elections and the Johnson County Clerk each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

In response to the previous version, officials from the St. Charles County Election Authority and the St. Louis City Board of Elections each assumed this proposal would have no impact on their organizations.

**Oversight** notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.
