<u>§407.932 – Tobacco products</u>

Officials from the **Department of Mental Health**, the **Department of Revenue**, the **Department of Public Safety – Division of Alcohol and Tobacco Control**, the **City of Kansas City** and the **City of O'Fallon** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

In response to similar legislation, HB 2060 (2024), officials from **Office of Administration** - **Budget and Planning** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities and counties were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
