ASSUMPTION

§302.171 – Gender Designations on Driver's Licenses, Non-driver's Licenses and Permits

Officials from the **Department of Revenue (DOR)** assume the following regarding this proposal:

The proposed language defines that a person applying for a license, permit or non-driver identification card issued with a gender other than the applicant's biological gender assigned at birth, must present medical documentation confirming gender reassignment surgery, or a court order declaring gender designation.

The Department's current procedures meet the provision of this proposal for required documents to request a sex indicator change. The only current available indicators for Missouri documents are either male or female. Other alternate designations are not allowed.

Administrative Impact

The proposed change may require a modification to related policies and procedures for processing such requests. This change will not require any system modifications in the current driver license system environment.

Oversight assumes DOR is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of activity each year. Oversight assumes DOR could absorb the costs related to this proposal. Officials from the DOR assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill specifies that in order to obtain a driver's license, nondriver's license, or instruction permit denoting a gender other than the applicant's biological gender assigned at birth, the applicant must provide medical documentation that he or she has undergone gender reassignment surgery or a court order declaring his or her gender designation.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
