ASSUMPTION

§§333.041-333.042 - Funeral Related Services Licensing

Officials from the **Department of Commerce and Insurance** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Oversight notes the balance of the Board of Embalmers & Funeral Directors fund (0633) balance at the end of December 2024 was \$3,053,393.21.

House Amendment 1 Oversight assumes House Amendment 1 will have no fiscal impact

House Amendment 2 - §324.263

Officials from the **Department of Commerce and Insurance (DCI)** assume this proposal is not anticipated to cause a fiscal impact beyond its current appropriation. However, if the workload significantly increases due to the expense of filing complaints with the AHC, additional resources will be requested through the appropriation process.

In response to a similar proposal from this year (HB 58), officials from **the Office of Administration - Administrative Hearing Commission** assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

House Amendment 3 - §§337.627 & 337.628

Officials from the **Department of Commerce and Insurance (DCI)** state costs are unknown at this time. The Committee for Social Workers is not aware of the number of pending accreditation programs in Missouri. Depending upon enrollment numbers, the Committee may need to hire additional staff. The committee may request additional FTE funding through the budget process.

Oversight assumes DCI is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of activity each year. Oversight assumes DCI could absorb the costs related to this proposal. If multiple bills pass which require additional staffing and duties at substantial costs, DCI could request funding through the appropriation process. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

In response to a similar proposal from this year (HB 268), officials from the **Department of Social Services** assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.
