Officials from the **Department of Commerce and Insurance**, the **Department of Social Services**, the **Missouri Department of Transportation**, the **Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan**, the **City of Osceola** and **Kansas City** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.
