#### **ASSUMPTION**

§ 632.359 - Inquiries of active warrants prior to release from a mental health facility

Officials from the Department of Mental Health, the Department of Corrections, the Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol, the Phelps County Sheriff's Department, the Kansas City Police Department, and the St. Louis County Police Department each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other sheriffs' departments and police departments were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
