ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Office of Administration - Administrative Hearing Commission, the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, the Department of Revenue, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the Office of Administration (General Services and Budget & Planning), the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules, and the Office of the Secretary of State each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight notes the proposal indicates that neither a franchisee nor a franchisee's employees shall be considered employees of a franchisor for any purpose unless the franchisor exercises direct and immediate control over the hiring, termination, discipline, and direction of the employees of a franchisee.
