### **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Office of Attorney General (AGO)** assume any potential litigation costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources. The AGO may seek additional appropriations if the proposal results in a significant increase in litigation or investigation costs.

**Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight assumes the AGO will be able to perform any additional duties required by this proposal with current staff and resources and will reflect no fiscal impact to the AGO for fiscal note purposes.

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE)** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organization. DESE notes time and effort, plus materials cost to produce/post the documents by the local education agencies (LEAs) are hard to determine.

Officials from the **Washington School District** assume the proposal will have a very limited financial impact. The proposal would require updating district material which is already completed annually.

**Oversight** assumes that cost resulting from this proposal would be negligible and school districts would be able to absorb those costs. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

**Oversight** received a limited number of responses from school districts related to the fiscal impact of this proposal. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information available. Upon the receipt of additional responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval to publish a new fiscal note.
