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**AN ACT**

To repeal section 210.203, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to records of complaints against child care facilities, with an emergency clause.

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*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 210.203, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu  
2 thereof, to be known as section 210.203, to read as follows:

210.203. The department of elementary and secondary education shall maintain a  
2 record of substantiated, signed parental complaints against child care facilities licensed  
3 pursuant to this chapter, and shall make such complaints and findings available to the public  
4 upon request. **No information identifying reporters of such complaints shall be made**  
5 **available to the public.**

Section B. Because immediate action is necessary to protect the privacy and safety of  
2 those persons who file complaints against child care facilities, section A of this act is deemed  
3 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, peace, and safety, and  
4 is hereby declared to be an emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and section  
5 A of this act shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.

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EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets **[thus]** in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
