### AN ACT

To amend chapter 105, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to optional alternative work schedules for agencies.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 105, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 105.009, to read as follows:

105.009. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, it shall not be a violation of this chapter or any other state labor law or statute for a state agency, state department, or division thereof to approve and adopt an alternative, compressed work week schedule of a four-day work week composed of ten hours a day. State agencies, departments, or divisions thereof may allow an alternative ten-hour, four-day work week if it is deemed appropriate by the director or other appropriate authority.

8 2. If a state holiday falls on a state employee's regularly scheduled ten-hour 9 work day, the employee shall not be required to use annual leave to make up the 10 difference between the eight hours of credited holiday time and the employee's regularly 11 scheduled ten-hour day.
