## AN ACT

To amend chapter 226, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the statewide transportation improvement program.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 226, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 226.034, to read as follows:

226.034. 1. Any member of the general assembly, county commissioner, or  
2 mayor of a city, town, or village who is dissatisfied with any action or decision included  
3 in the statewide transportation improvement program (STIP) may seek review of such  
4 action or decision by the administrative hearing commission. Such review shall be  
5 sought by the filing of a petition with the administrative hearing commission within  
6 thirty days of the publication date of the annual STIP. If any such petition is sent by  
7 registered mail or certified mail, it shall be deemed filed on the date it is mailed; if it is  
8 sent by any method other than registered mail or certified mail, it shall be deemed filed  
9 on the date it is received by the commission.

10 2. The procedures applicable to such hearings and determinations shall be those  
11 established by chapter 536.
