## AN ACT

To repeal section 9.010, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to election day.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 9.010, RSMo, is repealed and two new sections enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as sections 9.010 and 173.015, to read as follows:

9.010. The first day of January, the third Monday of January, the twelfth day of February, the third Monday in February, the eighth day of May, the last Monday in May, the nineteenth day of June, the fourth day of July, the first Monday in September, the second Monday in October, the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of evennumbered years, the eleventh day of November, the fourth Thursday in November, and the twenty-fifth of December, are declared and established public holidays; and when any of such holidays falls upon Sunday, the Monday next following shall be considered the holiday. There shall be no holiday for state employees on the fourth Monday of October.

173.015. The board shall require that all colleges and universities be closed on 2 the general election day, unless such college or university serves as a polling place.
