## AN ACT

To amend chapter 227, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to highway designations.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 227, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 227.850, to read as follows:

3 **227.850. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the department**  
4 **of transportation shall not erect any sign designating a highway named for any person**  
5 **who has been convicted of the killing of, or the attempted killing of, a law enforcement**  
6 **officer or permit any signage in the convicted person's memory. Any such sign in place**  
7 **prior to August 28, 2025, shall be removed.**
