AN ACT

To repeal section 211.221, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the placement of a child.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 211.221, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 211.221, to read as follows:

211.221. In placing a child in or committing a child to the custody of an individual or
of a private agency or institution the court, children's division, or any child placing agency
contracting with the state to provide foster care services shall whenever practicable select
either a person, or an agency or institution governed by persons of the same religious faith as

5 that of the parents of such child, or in case of a difference in the religious faith of the parents,

6 then of the religious faith of the child or if the religious faith of the child is not ascertainable,

7 then of the faith of either of the parents.
