## AN ACT

To amend chapter 9, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to monthly historical designations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 9, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 9.025, to read as follows:

9.025. The following historical designations shall be celebrated in Missouri each

- 2 month on a yearly basis:
- 3 (1) January as Veterans History Month;
- 4 (2) February as Black History Month;
- 5 (3) March as Women's History Month;
- 6 (4) April as Arts History Month;
- 7 (5) May as County and Community History Month;
- 8 (6) June as Sports History Month;
- 9 (7) July as Liberty History Month;
- 10 (8) August as Missouri History Month;
- 11 (9) September as Humanities History Month;
- 12 (10) October as Agriculture History Month;
- 13 (11) November as Native American History Month; and
- 14 (12) December as Religion History Month.
