2	such as the balanced budget amendment, but there is legal disagreement on whether a
3	convention called by state legislatures would be legally bound to limit discussion to a single

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the House of Representatives of the One Hundred Third General Assembly, First Regular Session, the Senate concurring therein, hereby rescind, nullify, cancel, supersede, and render null and void all resolutions and applications previously made by the Missouri General Assembly for the United States Congress to call a convention for proposing amendments to the United States Constitution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Missouri General Assembly requests that this resolution be published in the Congressional Record and listed in the official tally of state legislative applications for the United States Congress to call a convention for the purpose of proposing amendments to the United States Constitution; and
