AN ACT

To amend chapter 379, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the procurement of driving data by automobile insurers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 379, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 379.1650, to read as follows:

379.1650. 1. As used in this section, the following terms mean:

(1) "Driving data", information collected by a vehicle through the vehicle's telematics system;

(2) "Insurer", any insurance company, association, or exchange authorized to issue policies of automobile insurance in this state;

(3) "Telematics system", a system or device in a vehicle that retrieves data generated by the vehicle, including the vehicle's global positioning system position, speed, diagnostic information and vehicle faults, trip distance or time, idling time, instances of sudden or harsh braking or driving, seat belt use, and fuel consumption.

2. An insurer shall not purchase or obtain from any third party:

(1) The driving data of a vehicle insured under a policy of automobile insurance issued by the insurer; or

(2) Any document or report based on the driving data of a vehicle insured under a policy of automobile insurance issued by the insurer.
