AN ACT

To amend chapter 321, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to taxes for emergency services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

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Section A. Chapter 321, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 321.905, to read as follows:

321.905. 1. For the purposes of this section, the term "political subdivision" shall mean:

- (1) Any municipality located within a county with more than one million inhabitants;
- (2) Any county with more than four hundred thousand but fewer than five hundred thousand inhabitants;
- 7 (3) Any county with more than two hundred thirty thousand but fewer than two 8 hundred sixty thousand inhabitants;
 - (4) Any county with more than one hundred thousand but fewer than one hundred twenty thousand inhabitants and with a county seat with more than four thousand but fewer than six thousand inhabitants; and
- 12 **(5)** Any county with more than two hundred sixty thousand but fewer than three 13 hundred thousand inhabitants.
- 2. The governing body of a political subdivision may, by a majority vote of its governing body, levy and collect ad valorem taxes on all real property located within the political subdivision, which shall not exceed twenty-five cents per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation, for the purposes of providing fire protection services; provided that,

| 41 | with a property tax reduction for each year in which the sales tax is imposed, for the |
| 42 | provision of ambulance or fire protection services by the ambulance district, fire |
| 43 | protection district, or the political subdivision; provided that, no ordinance or order |
| 44 | enacted pursuant to this section shall be effective unless the governing body submits to |
| 45 | the voters of the ambulance district, fire protection district, or political subdivision, a |
| 46 | proposal to authorize the governing body to impose a sales tax and reduce property |
| 47 | taxes. |

 If a majority of the votes cast on the proposal by the qualified voters voting thereon are in favor of the proposal, then the ordinance or order and any amendments thereto shall be in effect. If a majority of the votes cast by the qualified voters voting are opposed to the proposal, then the governing body of the district or political subdivision shall have no power to impose the sales tax and reduce the property tax as herein authorized unless and until the governing body of the district or political subdivision shall again have submitted another proposal to authorize the governing body to impose the sales tax and reduce the property tax.

- 5. The total property tax levy subject to reduction pursuant to this section shall not include those taxes levied to retire indebtedness.
- 6. Each year in which a sales tax is imposed pursuant to this section, the ambulance district, fire protection district, or political subdivision shall, after determining its budget for the provision of ambulance or fire protection services within the limits set by the constitution and laws of this state for the following calendar year and the total property tax levy needed to raise the revenues required by such budget, reduce the total property tax levy imposed pursuant to this chapter or chapter 190, as applicable, in an amount sufficient to decrease the total property taxes it will collect by an amount equal to fifty percent of the sales tax revenue collected pursuant to this section in the tax year for which the property taxes are being levied. In the event that in the immediately preceding year the ambulance district, fire protection district, or the political subdivision actually collected more or less sales tax revenue, the ambulance district, fire protection district, or the political subdivision shall adjust its total property tax levy for the current year to reflect such increase or decrease.

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
