## AN ACT

To repeal section 227.503, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to the Heart of America Bridge.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 227.503, RSMo, is repealed and two new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 227.503 and 227.887, to read as follows:

227.503. The bi-directional pedestrian and bicycle path on the **Sam Graves** Heart of America Bridge, which carries Route 9 over the Missouri River in Kansas City, Missouri, shall be designated the "Bob Watts Memorial Bicycle & Pedestrian Bridge". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such pedestrian and bicycle lane, with the costs to be paid for by private donations.

227.887. **The Heart of America Bridge, which carries Route 9 over the Missouri River in Kansas City, shall be renamed the "Sam Graves Heart of America Bridge".** The department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such bridge, with the costs to be paid by private donations.
