AN ACT

To amend chapter 160, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to panic-alert technology in schools.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 160, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 160.072, to read as follows:

160.072. 1. Each school district and charter school shall provide a school employee in each classroom with mobile panic-alert technology that allows for immediate contact and two-way communication with local emergency communications systems, law enforcement agencies, fire departments, and school administration.

2. Each school district and charter school shall provide each school employee in a school facility with mobile panic-alert technology that allows for immediate contact and two-way communication with local emergency communications systems.

3. Prior to the first school day of each school year, each school district and charter school shall ensure that each school employee in a school facility receives training on the protocol for and appropriate use of the mobile panic-alert technology.
