## AN ACT

To repeal section 451.022, RSMo, relating to same sex marriages.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 451.022, RSMo, is repealed, to read as follows:

[451.022. 1. It is the public policy of this state to recognize marriage2only between a man and a woman.32. Any purported marriage not between a man and a woman is invalid.43. No recorder shall issue a marriage license, except to a man and a5woman.64. A marriage between persons of the same sex will not be recognized7for any purpose in this state even when valid where contracted.]
