

HB 71 -- MISSOURI GEOSPATIAL ADVISORY COUNCIL

SPONSOR: Taylor (48)

This bill establishes the "Missouri Geospatial Advisory Council", within the Office of Administration. The council shall consist of 32 members, the makeup of which is provided in the bill. Additional subject matter experts may participate in activities as non-council members. Members of the council will serve three-year terms without compensation.

The council will meet monthly and as otherwise required. It may apply for federal and state grants to sponsor and publish surveys and to solicit or develop proposals for projects related to state geospatial data infrastructure.

The duties of the council are provided in the bill.

This bill is the same as HB 2191 (2024) and similar to HB 475 (2023).
