HB 138 -- MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION (Justus)

COMMITTEE OF ORIGIN: Standing Committee on Legislative Review

This bill clarifies that the Department of Revenue cannot release the home address or any other information that identifies a vehicle owned or leased by any person who is an active or retired county, State, or Federal parole officer, Federal pretrial officer, a peace officer, a person vested under the Missouri Constitution with judicial power, a member of the Federal judiciary, or a member of such person's immediate family contained in the Department's motor vehicle or driver registration records.

This bill also provides that the application for a Missouri Conservation Heritage Foundation emblem license plate and payment of the \$25 contribution can be made at the time of registration to the Director of the Department of Revenue, who must deposit the contribution to the credit of the Missouri Conservation Heritage Foundation.

Finally, this bill modifies the applicable professional sports teams for which a person can receive a special license plate to include the National Women's Soccer League.
