

HB 344 -- TOBACCO PRODUCTS

SPONSOR: Keathley

This bill specifies that the state preempts and supersedes all local laws, ordinances, orders, rules, or regulations enacted by a county, municipality, or other political subdivision regulating the sale of tobacco products, alternative nicotine products, or vapor products.

This bill is the same as HB 2060 (2024) and is similar to HB 1039 (2023) and SB 522 (2023).
