HB 860 -- INCOME TAX DEDUCTIONS FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION

SPONSOR: Simmons

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Special Committee on Tax Reform by a vote of 6 to 3.

Beginning January 1, 2026, this bill allows taxpayers to subtract from their Federal adjusted gross income 100% of overtime compensation.

Beginning January 1, 2026, this bill allows taxpayers to subtract from their Federal adjusted gross income 100% of any tips received or paid to a tipped employee engaged in an occupation that customarily and regularly receives tips.

This bill is similar to HB 198(2025) and SB 452(2023).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this bill will help people to keep their money.

Testifying in person for the bill was Representative Simmons.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
