HB 866 -- LOCAL PUBLIC SAFETY SALES TAX

SPONSOR: Riggs

This bill adds certain cities to the list of cities authorized to enact, upon voter approval, a sales tax of up to 0.5% for the purpose of improving public safety, limited to expenditures on equipment, salaries and benefits, and facilities for police, fire, and emergency medical providers.

Upon enactment, the cities of Hannibal and Moberly will be so authorized.

This bill is the same as HB 2290 (2024).
