

HB 1074 -- SCHOOL SAFETY

SPONSOR: Allen

This bill requires local educational agencies to report to the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) all school safety incidents and credible school safety threats that occur at each attendance center of the local educational agency, including, but not limited to, all actual incidents or credible threats of school shootings or other incidents or threats involving a firearm, explosive, knife, or other weapon, as provided in the bill.

The bill requires DESE to establish procedures for local educational agencies to follow when reporting a school safety incident or credible threat. These procedures must include, but are not limited to, criteria to assist local educational agencies in determining what constitutes a school safety incident or credible threat that is required to be reported; a timeframe within which the incident or threat must be reported; and any other information required by DESE.

DESE will maintain and regularly update a database of all school safety incidents and credible school safety threats that are reported.

This bill is the same as SB 68 (2025).
