HB 1472 -- PANIC-ALERT TECHNOLOGY IN SCHOOLS

SPONSOR: Justus

This bill provides that each school district and charter school must provide a school employee in each classroom with a mobile panic-alert technology that allows for immediate contact and two-way communication with local emergency communications systems, law enforcement agencies, fire departments, and school administration.

Prior to the first school day of each school year, each school district and charter school must ensure that each school employee in a school facility receives training on the appropriate use of the mobile panic-alert technology.
