As an International Baccalaureate educator of Theory of Knowledge, Personal and Professional Skills, and Psychology courses, I can testify that the education that my students receive through the IB curriculum is above most lower-level college courses. My students continually contact me and tell me how easy their college courses are in the first two years of their experience. This is in part due to the rigorous curriculum IB provides in the areas of approaches to learning, Inquiry, research, and writing. Students who receive top scores in the IB program and earn the diploma are hard-working individuals				

who go on to reach a high degree of success in post-graduate programs. If more schools would award IB students credit for our students, it would increase enrollment in the IB program and give students more choices when thinking about which universities to attend. The passage of HB 1017 would also allow students to save money on tuition. Also, students would be allowed to direct their focus on advanced classes that pertain to their overall educational goals.
