According to the U.S. Chamber Institute for Legal Reform, Missouri ranks 44th in the nation for its legal climate, a status that can increase insurance and litigation costs and, in turn, drive up infrastructure expenses for taxpavers. By capping contractor liability, HB1067 helps ensure more predictable project costs. This bill does not excuse negligence; contractors remain accountable for meeting contractual obligations and acting responsibly. HB1067 simply prevents unfair legal exposure when contractors properly follow MoDOT directives. Since MoDOT already operates with sovereign immunity and a liability cap, contractors should not bear a greater legal burden than the agency itself. Extending these protections helps maintain a level playing field, encourages competition, and ultimately benefits the public through more cost-effective projects.
