The Missouri Catholic Conference supports the General Assembly's efforts to protect the life of the most vulnerable among us. To this end, we urge the committee to support HBs 195 and 1119. This should go without saying, but no newborn should be left to suffer or die without medical care. Whether the child receives care after birth should not be determined by whether he or she was wanted. Current law provides no specific mechanism for holding an abortionist accountable if he denies care to babies who survive abortions. These bills clarify the penalties for a doctor that fails to provide the proper level of care, or who knowingly causes the death of a born child. HBs 195 and 1119 would provide more concrete protection for those children that survive abortions and as such, we recommend the committee vote DO PASS.

Thank you, Chairperson Stinnet and committee, for bringing these bills up for a hearing. I would like to encourage this committee to heartily “vote do” pass on these wonderful pieces of legislation. I say wonderful, because if passed and finally agreed this will literally save the lives of Missourians. But it is also tragic in that we even need to be having this conversation. I never cease to be stricken by how many people out there think it is okay to deprive others of personhood and even life itself. In America’s past there were those who considered persons of a particular race to be less than human. They were slaves, owned as property of others. They could be killed by their masters and no one thought anything of it. They often were not killed by their masters because of the economic impact that would have had – there was a financial incentive to keep them alive and perhaps sell them off to someone else. But they were not valued as persons, and their life was not considered an inalienable right. Fortunately – though there is still some work to do - we have corrected that error in our nation’s past. More recently the nation of Germany – in the 1930’s and early 40’s – considered Jews to be less than human, deprived of personhood, and even considered “vermin”. Fortunately, the world – led the United States of America – put a stop to that by defeating the Nazi’s in WWII. But here in 21st century America there are many who consider babies as less than human, deprived of personhood, and regulated to being nothing more than a clump of cells. Deprived of their inalienable right to life and liberty. Some would go so far as to say that babies are “vermin”, posing health risk to their own mothers. And tragically, they are often seen as not being financially viable. There are children dying not because of their race or ethnic heritage, but simply because of their age or the fact that they are unwanted by their parents. Though the Romans claimed to be civilized, they were the true barbarians. In the Roman culture if a baby was unwanted, they would simply take them to the dump and allow them to die by “exposure” – the heat of the sun, the cold of the night, the hunger, the rodents . . . the child would soon die of neglect. Thankfully, with the spread of Christianity and its unwavering commitment to the sanctity of all human life, that practice ended and the culture began to find ways to care for these unwanted children. To say that these children that survive an abortion are unwanted and should be discarded is a farce! They may be unwanted by their mother, but there are approximately 2 million families in the US today who would like to adopt a baby. Rather than killing our children we need to be working on a way to make adoption more accessible. Finally, let me ask a simple question . . . if we can allow an infant who just survived an attempt to kill it to die, then will it be okay to allow a 6 month old baby to die if they are unwanted? What about a 2 year old – they can be pretty challenging too, you know....or a 13 year old? Man! There are times when every parent has been tempted, right? Or what about an old man sitting before you making some of you uncomfortable by my forthright discussion of the fact that every human life is valuable and is to be protected with the same passion and vigor and attention as every other human life. Are we going to strive to be better than the Romans, better than our American forefathers, and better than the Nazi’s? Are we going to rise above the past evils of

humanity, or are we going to join them in their atrocities?I expect a unanimous vote of “do pass” on HB195 and 1119.

House Committee on Health and Mental Health February 4, 2025 Testimony to Oppose HB 195 and HB 1119 Planned Parenthood Great Plains Votes (PPGPV) vehemently opposes HB 195 and HB 1119, which in action would unconstitutionally ban abortion for some patients in the state and criminalize individuals who assist a pregnant person in obtaining an abortion. These bills, referred to as the “Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act,” are disingenuous in nature, as they attack a pregnant person’s access to reproductive freedom and further politicize access to abortion in Missouri by using inflammatory language, without any basis in science or reality. These bills not only attempt to criminalize abortion but also imply that medical professionals are not providing care that meets appropriate medical standards. These claims are blatantly false, and the language contained in these bills is meant to stoke rage and fear of actions that are simply not occurring. These bills advance false narratives about abortion and impose mandates designed by politicians instead of doctors. This not only interferes with medical practice but denies physicians the ability to provide the care that is necessary, compassionate, and appropriate under complex circumstances. Abortion providers are already required to comply with existing medical laws and standards of care, just like other medical professionals. These bills seek to inject politicians into patient-provider relationships, disregarding providers’ training and clinical judgment and undermining their ability to determine the best course of action with their patients. The law cannot account for every potential complication in pregnancy and should not require specific medical care for all situations. Care offered to patients later in pregnancy involves a team of specialists who are experts in the provision of care and support of families in extremely difficult circumstances. The legislature’s attempt to confuse and upset Missourians at the expense of patients is deeply alarming. The legislation is offensive to pregnant people and the medical professionals who provide their care and could have devastating impacts on families experiencing complex pregnancy outcomes. These bills, if codified, would give a right of action for a wrongful personal injury, bodily injury, or wrongful death against abortion providers and pregnant people who obtained an abortion, by someone with familial ties to the fetus. This has far-reaching implications as it would allow people to attack providers and provide a new avenue for abusive partners to harass and surveil their victims. Each year, approximately 500,000 women are physically assaulted or raped by an intimate partner; three out of 10 women at some point are stalked, physically assaulted, or raped by an intimate partner.¹ Missouri should be protecting people who can get pregnant from their abusive partners, not providing abusers a path to continue attacks on someone that they may have raped, stalked, or otherwise abused. In November 2024, the majority of Missourian’s voted to ensure that the “right to reproductive freedom shall not be denied, interfered with, delayed, or otherwise restricted.” This constitutional amendment, known as Amendment 3, would override the provisions of this bill if it were to become law, as the highest legal authority in the state. This is just another attempt to create a political opportunity to drive a false narrative to stigmatize reproductive

health care. For these reasons, we firmly urge the Committee to hold bills HB 195 and HB 1119.
