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As a retired teacher and educator activist, I have had much interaction over the years with forms of alternate certifications for teaching. I remember the early days of ABCTE which was colloquially called "Any Body Can Teach Everything." This is not to say that colleges of education are the only way to					

train teachers but they have improved immensely in the years since I was in teacher education programs. Getting prospective teachers into classrooms in a variety of ways very early in their training, in fact often as high school students doing tutoring for the A+ program, is a great improvement. We are also doing a much better job of mentoring young or beginning teachers. Please be sure that you have done adequate research into the experiences of alternative certification programs before adopting them for our Missouri schools.
