There are just shy of 14.000 kids in foster care in Missouri. And while many of these will eventually be re-united with their family of origin - and that is our goal - there are many more who will not. Additionally, many abortions are performed because the mother sees no other option. Adoption is insanely expensive, and there are families who would love to adopt - either from the foster care system or from moms who see the only alternative is to kill their child - but these families cannot afford to adopt. The lack of finances to pay attorneys and other fees by the prospective adoptive family, results in the children being stuck in foster care until they are 18, or being killed by their own mothers. But this bill would help alleviate costs for families seeking to adopt, and thus we will have more adoptions. The increase in adoptions is good as it will reduce the number of children in foster care that are available for adoption and awaiting families able to do so. It is also good in that more babies will live. Everyone claims we want to do the best thing "for the children" . . . what could be better for a child than being adopted into a loving home with stability, and belonging rather than being bounced from house to house in foster care? Allowing tax credit for those who support adoption is reasonable in that they are aiding in the state's interest of finding permanent homes for these children so they are not raised in foster care their whole life. Furthermore, as kids are adopted into loving families, it will reduce the strain and the expense of the foster care system.
