The Missouri Catholic Conference supports the General Assembly's efforts to protect the life of the most vulnerable among us. To this end, we urge the committee to support HBs 195 and 1119. This should go without saying, but no newborn should be left to suffer or die without medical care. Whether the child receives care after birth should not be determined by whether he or she was wanted. Current law provides no specific mechanism for holding an abortionist accountable if he denies care to babies who survive abortions. These bills clarify the penalties for a doctor that fails to provide the proper level of care, or who knowingly causes the death of a born child. HBs 195 and 1119 would provide more concrete protection for those children that survive abortions and as such, we recommend the committee vote DO PASS.

Thank you, Chairperson Stinnet and committee, for bringing these bills up for a hearing. I would like to encourage this committee to heartily "vote do" pass on these wonderful pieces of legislation. I say wonderful, because if passed and finally agreed this will literally save the lives of Missourians. But it is also tragic in that we even need to be having this conversation. I never cease to be stricken by how many people out there think it is okay to deprive others of personhood and even life itself. In America's past there were those who considered persons of a particular race to be less than human. They were slaves, owned as property of others. They could be killed by their masters and no one thought anything of it. They often were not killed by their masters because of the economic impact that would have had - there was a financial incentive to keep them alive and perhaps sell them off to someone else. But they were not valued as persons, and their life was not considered an inalienable right. Fortunately - though there is still some work to do - we have corrected that error in our nation's past. More recently the nation of Germany – in the 1930's and early 40's – considered Jews to be less than human, deprived of personhood, and even considered "vermin". Fortunately, the world - led the United States of America – put a stop to that by defeating the Nazi's in WWII. But here in 21st century America there are many who consider babies as less than human, deprived of personhood, and regulated to being nothing more than a clump of cells. Deprived of their inalienable right to life and liberty. Some would go so far as to say that babies are "vermin", posing health risk to their own mothers. And tragically, they are often seen as not being financially viable. There are children dying not because of their race or ethnic heritage, but simply because of their age or the fact that they are unwanted by their parents. Though the Romans claimed to be civilized, they were the true barbarians. Finally, let me ask a simple guestion . . . if we can allow an infant who just survived an attempt to kill it to die, then will it be okay to allow a 6 month old baby to die if they are unwanted? What about a 2 year old - they can be pretty challenging too, you know....or a 13 year old? Man! There are times when every parent has been tempted, right? Or what about an old man sitting before you making some of you uncomfortable by my forthright discussion of the fact that every human life is valuable and is to be protected with the same passion and vigor and attention as every other human life. Are we going to strive to be better than the Romans, better than our American forefathers, and better than the Nazi's? Are we going to rise above the past evils of

humanity, or are we going to join them in their atrocities? I expect a unanimous vote of "do pass" on HB195 and 1119.

Notwithstanding subsection 3 of this Section, the general assembly may enact laws that regulate the provision of abortion after Fetal Viability provided that under no circumstance shall the Government deny, interfere with, delay, or otherwise restrict an abortion that in the good faith judgment of a treating health care professional is needed to protect the life or physical or mental health of the pregnant person.5. No person shall be penalized, prosecuted, or otherwise subjected to adverse action based on their actual, potential, perceived, or alleged pregnancy outcomes, including but not limited to miscarriage, stillbirth, or abortion. Nor shall any person assisting a person in exercising their right to reproductive freedom with that person's consent be penalized, prosecuted, or otherwise subjected to adverse action for doing so.6. The Government shall not discriminate against persons providing or obtaining reproductive health care or assisting another person in doing so.7. If any provision of this Section or the application thereof to anyone or any circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of those provisions and the application of such provisions to others or other circumstances shall not be affected thereby.8. For purposes of this Section, the following terms mean: (1) "Fetal Viability", the point in pregnancy when, in the good faith judgment of a treating health care professional and based on the particular facts of the case, there is a significant likelihood of the fetus's sustained survival outside the uterus without the application of extraordinary medical measures.(2) "Government", a. the state of Missouri; orb. any municipality, city, town, village, township, district, authority, public subdivision of public corporation having the power to tax or regulate, or any portion of two or more such entities within the state of Missouri.

This has far-reaching implications as it would allow people to attack providers and provide a new avenue for abusive partners to harass and surveil their victims.
