This is especially dangerous late at night when passengers are waiting to board or immediately after they disembark. Without their ability to defend themselves they are easy prey for would be attackers.CCW permit holders are not the problem. They have been photographed, fingerprinted, investigated, and vetted. They must demonstrate competence with a firearm. Police officers are six times more likely to commit misdemeanors or felonies than CCW permit holders.It has been claimed that the presence of CCW permit holders would unduly alarm many passengers and they would abandon public transportation although it was not explained how passengers would be aware that a CONCEALED weapon was present. It is curious to me that these same passengers are not alarmed to the point of abandonment by the possibility of criminal elements carrying illegal firearms.

As a mother of two young children, one of my greatest concerns is the safety of my children. Due to the recent history of increasing gun violence and mass shootings in our country, I already have increased daily anxiety and fear for my kids' safety when sending them to school, or visiting grocery stores, parades, or movie theatres with them. I am acutely aware of all exits everywhere I go and have nightmares about how to prioritize both children in worst case scenarios. These fears are not unfounded: Missouri's rate of gun deaths has increased 59% from 2012 to 2021, compared to a 33% increase nationwide. HB 328 jeopardizes public safety by permitting concealed firearms on public transportation and in places of worship, among other concerning changes. Public buses and terminals are high-traffic areas where stress and conflicts can arise quickly. Introducing firearms into these spaces increases the likelihood of accidental shootings, heated confrontations turning deadly, and even mass shootings. For instance, in 2023, a heated argument on a Chicago bus led to a fatal shooting, leaving passengers traumatized. Allowing guns in these environments puts everyone at risk, particularly vulnerable groups like children, seniors, and individuals with disabilities. Public transportation should remain a secure space, free from the added danger of firearms. Additionally, the bill lowers the age requirement for concealed carry permits from 19 to 18, despite evidence that younger individuals are more likely to act impulsively. Research from the National Institutes of Health confirms that the brain's decision-making abilities are not fully developed until the mid-20s. Allowing 18-year-olds to carry concealed weapons in public ignores this reality and increases the chances of firearm-related accidents or violence. For example, in 2021, a 19-year-old in Texas mishandled a firearm in a crowded park, accidentally shooting a bystander. Lowering the age requirement will only lead to more preventable tragedies, endangering communities across the state. Worse yet, the bill removes essential protections by allowing individuals with violent misdemeanor convictions to obtain concealed carry permits. This undermines the intent of background checks, which are designed to prevent dangerous individuals from carrying firearms. For instance, someone convicted of assault or stalking could now legally carry a concealed weapon, putting their victims and the public at greater risk. Furthermore, allowing firearms in places of worship disregards the sanctity of these spaces, which should be sanctuaries of peace, not places where congregants feel unsafe. This bill prioritizes gun access over the safety and well-being of the public, and it must be opposed.

HB 328 poses a significant threat to public safety by allowing concealed carry permit holders to bring firearms onto public transportation and into places of worship, among other concerning provisions. Public transportation, such as buses and terminals, are crowded spaces where tensions can run high, and introducing firearms into these environments increases the risk of accidental discharges. escalations of conflicts, and mass shootings. For example, in 2021, a dispute on a New York City subway escalated into a shooting, injuring innocent bystanders. Allowing firearms on buses and in terminals would only exacerbate such risks, putting passengers—especially vulnerable populations like children, the elderly, and those with disabilities—in harm's way. Public transportation should remain a safe space for all, free from the added danger of firearms. Furthermore, the bill dangerously lowers the age requirement for concealed carry permits from 19 to 18 years old, despite overwhelming evidence that younger individuals are more prone to impulsive behavior and poor decision-making. According to the American Psychological Association, the prefrontal cortex, which governs impulse control and judgment, is not fully developed until the mid-20s. Allowing 18-year-olds to carry concealed weapons in public spaces ignores this scientific reality and increases the likelihood of firearm-related accidents or violence. For instance, in 2022, an 18-year-old in Ohio accidentally discharged a firearm in a crowded mall, injuring two people. Lowering the age requirement for concealed carry permits would only make such incidents more common, endangering communities across Missouri. Finally, HB 328 removes critical safeguards by allowing individuals with prior convictions for violent misdemeanors to obtain concealed carry permits. This provision undermines the purpose of background checks and permits, which are designed to ensure that only responsible, law-abiding citizens carry firearms in public. For example, someone convicted of domestic violence or assault within the past five years could now legally carry a concealed weapon, increasing the risk of harm to their victims or others. Additionally, the bill's expansion of concealed carry into places of worship disregards the sanctity and safety of these spaces. Churches and other religious institutions are meant to be places of peace and refuge, not environments where congregants must worry about the presence of firearms. HB 328 prioritizes the interests of gun owners over the safety and well-being of the general public, and for these reasons, it must be opposed.

While intended to improve safetyand protect Second Amendment rights, it's crucial Missourians understand the unimaginablerisks and why the Missouri Public Transit Association and all transit providers statewideadamantly oppose it. Just like on airplanes and Amtrak — where guns are not allowed — public transit vehicles areenclosed, moving environments that pose imminent danger for passengers and operators should an accidental discharge or planned attack occur. We know safety is paramount. The largest Missouri transit providers provide tens of millions ofrides each year and have publicly expressed opposition to conceal and carry on transit. That's why transit officials in both rural and urban areas are working to enhance safety programsincluding working directly with law enforcement agencies to increase police presence onsystems. Real-time camera centers and systems are serving as force multipliers; a \$52 million, state-of-the-art security plan is being implemented in St. Louis; and partnerships have beenestablished to connect riders in need of mental health assistance with providers at several agencies. OATS is in the process of implementing a real time camera system on its vehicles. Transit safety is being addressed each day. Finally, the ATU which represents thousands of transit operators in the state is adamantly opposed to these bills as they inherently place their members at risk. These operators are essential to ensuring our communities continue to have good access to jobs, education andhealthcare. Other organizations like Greater St. Louis, Inc.; City of Kansas City, and Citizens for ModernTransit have all testified previously in opposition to these bills. Transit is having a significant positive economic impact on our state to the tune of more than \$4 billion annually. Impairing the ability of transit providers to deliver service with a bill like this will impact the state'sbottom line. This bill is personal to transit riders across the state, and arming transit riders isnot the answer to enhancing the safety and security of these systems.
