I am in Full Support of this Bill and its intension for the increased Monthly Pension Payments to Certified Education Members (P.S.R.S.) and Non-Certified Education Employees (P.E.E.R.S.) with Local School Districts and Community College Districts, by making the Retiree Members whole and adequately keeping up with increased Costs, Yearly Inflation and Yield on the Pension Systems Investments. Current State Law and Pension Promulgated Rules Limit Monthly Pension Benefit Payments to 80% and 5% maximum increase per year for inflation, capped at 80% of the Retiree's Income amount. Inflation for the past four (4) Years has been 7%-2021, 6.5%-2022, 3.4%-2023, 2.9%-2024 and Projected 3% in 2025. This is a NEED and can be afforded by the Pension System with large percentage returns on investment for decades. Remember that Career Education Employees do not receive Social Security Payments, because they have not paid F.I.C.A. Payments, unless the Employee obtained the minimum required F.I.C.A. Credits by means of part-time jobs or previous employment. This is a fair Proposed Plan.

As of January 1, 2025, 2,831 PSRS retirees and 772 PEERS retirees have reached the 80% COLA cap. • These retirees, who dedicated their careers to public education, are now seeing their purchasing power eroded due to inflation, with no mechanism to adjust beyond the cap when they are at their most vulnerable age. It will take approximately 29.7 years (about 30 years) for a retiree to reach the 80% COLA cap with a 2% annual COLA increase. • With the average age at retirement is 58, meaning a

person would hit the the COLA cap at 88.As of January 1, 2025, 2,831 PSRS retirees and 772 PEERS retirees have reached the 80% COLA cap.

Dear House Pension Committee: I am a retired public school teacher who has been impacted by the COLA cap of my pension. I retired in 1992 after spending 8 years as a special education teacher and 23 years as an elementary principal. I had to retire because of some health issues but I was not allowed to stay retired. The school rehired me on a part-time basis as SPED director for 2 years. I then "retired" again and stayed home for 2 years. At that time a neighboring school called and asked me to be their elementary counselor for one day a week. I stayed there for 5 years. My home school then asked me to come back and help "straighten out the SPED department". I worked part time for 4 years, returned to full time for 3 years, then finished with 3 more years of part-time work. My "final retirement " lasted for 2 years then I became a volunteer in a small neighboring K-8 school. I have been volunteering at least one day a week for 14 yearsCounting full-time and part-time service I have been a paid educator for 47 years. Adding the 14 years of volunteer service I have spent a total of 61 years in the public school arena.(Since my initial retirement I have had 3 back surgeries, 2 eye surgeries and cancer surgery. It has been 8 1/2 years since cancer surgery but the doctor will not declare me cancer free because it is such a rare cancer. )I would be there on the 27th but I have made a commitment to 5 teachers and 75 students to be there for them and it would be difficult to change plans on such short notice. I work with 14 first graders and 19 second graders on sight words, 19 second graders on addition and subtraction facts, 19 fifth graders on multiplication facts, 1 fourth-grade student on reading (who was homeschooled for 3 years and is reading at beginning first-grade level), and 3 kindergartners who are working below grade level in reading. I work with all of these on an individual basis. Missouri has one of the best Teacher Retirement systems in the nation. However, my pension is not keeping up with the cost of living. With the COLA cap I have not had an increase for the last 3 years. I was not eligible for the last 5% increase the system provided because I had already capped out at 80%. When I first retired an 80% cap did not sound bad at all but I did not anticipate the actual cost of living increase. My income has been frozen for 3 years but my cost of living keeps increasing. My insurance (health, vehicle, home, etc.) has risen at an alarming pace, utilities are continuing to rise, grocery prices increase daily. The people who sell these services do not say, "Your income was frozen at 80% so we freeze your expenses at that rate." I am receiving an increase of 80% of my original retirement but paying 100% of the actual cost of living expenses. Please help the retired school personnel (current and future) with this situation. Ensuring their retirement benefits maintain value over time is a matter of fairness and respect for their service. Currently, retired members of the Public School Retirement System and the Public Education Employee Retirement System (PSRS/PEERS) may receive yearly COLAs on monthly retirement allowances, but the total of the COLAs must not exceed 80% of a member's original monthly retirement allowance. COLAs are vital to the financial stability and security of our retirees. If the system's investments earn 2% or greater returns than the investment return rate assumption, the limit on the total COLA cap must be increased by 1% and adopted by the Board. However, the COLAs must not exceed 100% of a member's original monthly retirement allowance. This proposal strikes the right balance between fiscal responsibility and supporting retirees. By allowing gradual, well-structured adjustments to the COLA cap, we protect retired educators, preserve the system's financial health, and ensure retirement benefits keep pace with economic realities.
