HB 353 allows a "new" newspaper to publish regularly and consecutively for one year, rather than three years, before it becomes a "legal" newspaper, eligible to publish notices. The bill also allows a newspaper that stops publication to be restarted within 90 days, currently 30 days, to continue its status as a "legal" newspaper. Missouri Press Association is in support of this legislation.
