I was a Federal Firearms Licensed dealer for 40 years until my recent retirement from that business. Any law that strips Constitutional 2nd amendment rights of a person WITHOUT A CRIMINAL HISTORY OF VIOLENCE preventing firearm possession, is blatantly unconstitutional. This bill would allow non-violent law-abiding citizens to retain their means of self-defense against lethal force during a period of time that is most critical for their health and well-being. Red Flag Laws make no sense. If a person is believed to be a danger to him or herself, taking away their firearms does not remove that danger. To truly remove the danger, the subject would have to be incarcerated or confined to a mental health facility. Without due process, none of this makes sense. Every Red Flag Law I have seen or heard of does three things: 1) They deprive the subject of their Second, Fourth, and Fifth Amendment rights under the U.S. Constitution. 2) They do not contain punitive provisions for frivolous claims. Someone could initiate such action to satisfy a grudge or get revenge on the subject. 3) It also is problematic when the subject is living with a spouse or other family member that also owns firearms. All the firearms are taken, depriving admittedly innocent people of their constitutional rights. I strongly urge you to pass this bill out of committee.

Red Flag– laws are critical life saving tools that help keep firearms out of the hands of people who should not have them. Missouri’s rate of gun deaths has increased 59% from 2012 to 2021, compared to a 33% increase nationwide. This means that in 2021 there were 532 more. lack of a red flag law also directly contributed to the shooting in 2022 at Central Visual and Performing Arts High School, as the shooter’s family pleaded with law enforcement to remove the shooter’s firearms when they noticed warning signs. Police said they felt powerless to remove the shooter’s gun because under Missouri’s nullification law they would be penalized for assisting in the enforcement of a federal gun law.

Extreme Risk Protection—or Red Flag—laws are critical life saving tools that help keep firearms out of the hands of people who should not have them. Missouri's rate of gun deaths has increased 59% from 2012 to 2021, compared to a 33% increase nationwide. In other words, in 2021 there were 532 more gun deaths in our state than in 2012. This is sickening and there is no logical reason to make guns more readily available to those who should not have them. In 2021, Missouri signed into law a bill to nullify federal gun safety laws here and penalize law enforcement officers for trying to enforce rules that protect Missourians from gun violence. "SAPA" was struck down by the United States Court of Appeals for the Eighth Circuit in August 2024. It was unconstitutional then and it is unconstitutional now.

For instance, states like Connecticut and Indiana have seen significant reductions in suicides and mass shootings thanks to red flag laws. By banning the enforcement of such measures, HB 434 and HB 459 would eliminate a vital tool for addressing crises, putting countless Missourians at risk. Contrary to the claims made in these bills, red flag laws are not implemented without due process. They require law enforcement or concerned family members to present evidence to a judge, who then decides whether a temporary order is justified. This ensures that individuals' rights are protected while addressing urgent threats. For example, after the Parkland school shooting, Florida's red flag law was used to disarm individuals who exhibited clear warning signs of violence, potentially saving lives. HB 434 and HB 459, however, would prevent Missouri from taking similar, responsible actions, even in cases where there is compelling evidence that someone poses a serious risk. This is not just irresponsible—it is a direct threat to public safety. Additionally, both bills attempt to undermine federal law and impose severe penalties on law enforcement agencies for enforcing red flag laws. This approach is not only unconstitutional but also counterproductive. By threatening agencies with \$50,000 fines and legal liability, these bills create a chilling effect that could discourage law enforcement from taking necessary steps to protect communities. This is especially concerning given Missouri's rising rates of gun violence and suicide. Red flag laws are not an attack on the Second Amendment; they are a balanced approach to ensuring public safety while respecting individual rights. HB 434 and HB 459 prioritize ideology over evidence-based solutions, putting lives at risk. For the safety of all Missourians, these bills must be rejected.

For instance, in Florida, the implementation of a red flag law after the Parkland school shooting has been used responsibly to disarm individuals who exhibited clear warning signs of violence. HB 434 and HB 459, however, would prevent Missouri from taking similar, life-saving actions, even when there is overwhelming evidence that someone poses a danger. This is not just irresponsible—it is reckless. Moreover, both bills attempt to nullify federal law and penalize law enforcement for enforcing red flag laws, which is not only unconstitutional but also counterproductive. By threatening agencies with hefty fines and legal liability, these bills create a chilling effect that could deter law enforcement from taking necessary actions to protect public safety. This is particularly troubling given the rising rates of gun violence and suicide in Missouri. Red flag laws are not about infringing on Second Amendment rights; they are about balancing individual freedoms with the collective right to safety. HB 434 and HB 459 prioritize ideology over evidence, and in doing so, they endanger the very citizens they claim to protect. For the sake of public safety and common sense, these bills must be rejected.

Extreme Risk Protection, or Red Flag, laws are lifesaving measures that help keep guns out of the hands of people who pose a danger to themselves or others. Without a Red Flag law, officers had no legal path to petition a court for the temporary removal of firearms, and the results were devastating. Missouri can and must do better to protect its communities from preventable tragedies.

Instead he killed 18 people and traumatized a community.
