pretrial actions. One might compare it to pretrial detention of a potentially dangerous subject, or of requiring a suspect's phone to be examined as evidence. Unlike some other pretrial actions, it seems that extreme risk orders have a definite time limit, usually 2 to 3 weeks, after which the person must be furnished with a judicial hearing. Not everyone who carries a gun is a good guy. Let's allow law enforcement to do its job unhindered.

This process ensures that individuals' rights are protected while addressing imminent threats. For instance, in Florida, the implementation of a red flag law after the Parkland school shooting has been used responsibly to disarm individuals who exhibited clear warning signs of violence. HB 434 and HB 459, however, would prevent Missouri from taking similar, life-saving actions, even when there is overwhelming evidence that someone poses a danger. This is not just irresponsible—it is reckless.Moreover, both bills attempt to nullify federal law and penalize law enforcement for enforcing red flag laws, which is not only unconstitutional but also counterproductive. By threatening agencies with hefty fines and legal liability, these bills create a chilling effect that could deter law enforcement from taking necessary actions to protect public safety. This is particularly troubling given the rising rates of gun violence and suicide in Missouri. Red flag laws are not about infringing on Second Amendment rights; they are about balancing individual freedoms with the collective right to safety. HB 434 and HB 459 prioritize ideology over evidence, and in doing so, they endanger the very citizens they claim to protect. For the sake of public safety and common sense, these bills must be rejected.
