Red Flag Laws make no sense. If a person is believed to be a danger to him or herself, taking away their firearms does not remove that danger. To truly remove the danger, the subject would have to be incarcerated or confined to a mental health facility. Without due process, none of this makes sense. Every Red Flag Law I have heard of does three things: 1) They deprive the subject of their Second, Fourth, and Fifth, Amendment rights under the U.S. Constitution. 2) They do not contain punitive provisions for frivolous claims. Someone could initiate such action to satisfy a grudge or get revenge on the subject. 3) It also is problematic when the subject is living with a spouse or other family member that also owns firearms. All the firearms are taken, depriving admittedly innocent people of their constitutional rights. I strongly urge you to pass this bill out of committee.

For instance, states like Connecticut and Indiana have seen significant reductions in suicides and mass shootings thanks to red flag laws. By banning the enforcement of such measures. HB 434 and HB 459 would eliminate a vital tool for addressing crises, putting countless Missourians at risk. Contrary to the claims made in these bills, red flag laws are not implemented without due process. They require law enforcement or concerned family members to present evidence to a judge, who then decides whether a temporary order is justified. This ensures that individuals' rights are protected while addressing urgent threats. For example, after the Parkland school shooting, Florida's red flag law was used to disarm individuals who exhibited clear warning signs of violence, potentially saving lives. HB 434 and HB 459, however, would prevent Missouri from taking similar, responsible actions, even in cases where there is compelling evidence that someone poses a serious risk. This is not just irresponsible—it is a direct threat to public safety. Additionally, both bills attempt to undermine federal law and impose severe penalties on law enforcement agencies for enforcing red flag laws. This approach is not only unconstitutional but also counterproductive. By threatening agencies with \$50,000 fines and legal liability, these bills create a chilling effect that could discourage law enforcement from taking necessary steps to protect communities. This is especially concerning given Missouri's rising rates of gun violence and suicide. Red flag laws are not an attack on the Second Amendment; they are a balanced approach to ensuring public safety while respecting individual rights. HB 434 and HB 459 prioritize ideology over evidence-based solutions, putting lives at risk. For the safety of all Missourians, these bills must be rejected.

This is not just irresponsible—it is reckless. Moreover, both bills attempt to nullify federal law and penalize law enforcement for enforcing red flag laws, which is not only unconstitutional but also counterproductive. By threatening agencies with hefty fines and legal liability, these bills create a chilling effect that could deter law enforcement from taking necessary actions to protect public safety. This is particularly troubling given the rising rates of gun violence and suicide in Missouri. Extreme Risk Protection, or Red Flag, laws are lifesaving measures that help keep guns out of the hands of people who pose a danger to themselves or others. Unfortunately, Missouri lacks such a law, and the consequences are heartbreaking. To make matters worse, Missouri passed a law in 2021 that attempted to nullify federal gun safety regulations and penalized law enforcement officers for enforcing them. This law, later ruled unconstitutional, directly impacted law enforcement's ability to act in life-ordeath situations. For example, the tragic 2022 shooting at Central Visual and Performing Arts High School could have been prevented. The shooter's family begged law enforcement to remove his firearm after noticing warning signs, but police said they felt powerless under Missouri's nullification law. Without a Red Flag law, officers had no legal path to petition a court for the temporary removal of firearms, and the results were devastating. Missouri can and must do better to protect its communities from preventable tragedies.
