The Missouri Voter Protection Coalition (MOVPC) supports HB 507, which would provide needed protection for election workers, and extend provisional voting to state and local elections,, among other valuable election administration measures. Election Worker Protections -- The legislation creates the offense of tampering with an election official, prohibiting harassment and intimidation of election workers. Ensuring the safety and security of our election workers is a top priority for MOVPC, and we. HB507 provides needed protections for election workers amid a growing spate of harassment, intimidation and threats to these dedicated civil servants — which are leading to a loss of needed election workers across the nation. A 2023 study of election workers by the Brennan Center found that:- Nearly 1/3 of election officials have been harassed, abused, or threatened because of their jobs;-More than 1/5 are concerned about being physically assaulted on the job in future elections- Some 45 percent reported concerns for the safety of other election officials and workers in future elections. -More than half expressed concern that the attacks will make it more difficult to retain or recruit election workers in future elections. This rings true here in Missouri. Our nonpartisan election protection hotline has seen an increase in reports of harassment and fears about intimidation. Missouri's association of clerks and election authorities have reported such incidents as well. More than a third of local election authorities in Missouri left their jobs following the 2022 midterm elections and their replacements administered their first federal and first presidential elections in 2024. The lack of specific protections has made it difficult for local election authorities to recruit and retain poll workers to administer elections, leading to polling place closures and other logistical challenges administering elections. Our bipartisan election workers work hard and do critically important work to ensure our elections run smoothly. We should ensure they feel safe doing so. The legislation also makes HAVA provisional ballots available at local elections as well as statewide and federal elections — This would provide a critically needed fix to a gap in provisional ballot access in Missouri. Currently, as mandated by federal law (the Help America Vote Act), voters whose eligibility cannot be immediately established can cast a provisional ballot during federal elections. These HAVA (or "yellow") provisional ballots are intended to ensure a way to vote for voters who whose eligibility cannot be immediately established at the polls. It ensures that valid voters are not harmed by errors in precinct rosters and provides a way for these voters to cast a ballot that can be vetted and counted later if it turns out they are eligible. It's high time that this right be extended all elections in Missouri as well to ensure all eligible voters can cast a ballot that counts. HB507 provides helpful election administration reforms. Missouri Voter Protection Coalition supports this legislation and urges the committee to vote YES.

My name if Patricia O'Roark and I am testifying in support of HB 507, a bill that would, if adopted into law, provide legal protections for election workers against harassment and intimidation. It would create the offense of tampering with an election official workers and their families. Election workers are necessary for a functional democracy. Nationally, one in six election workers have been intimidated, many have quit their jobs out of fear. It is getting more difficult to replace election workers who quit for any reason. Fewer election workers often make it necessary for officials to consolidate polling places. What makes the voting process legitimate in the eyes of the voter is the knowledge that their neighbors are counting the votes -- and people trust their neighbors. If they must travel miles to a polling place that trust can break down. When trust breaks down, our democracy becomes weaker. Further, HB 507 expands the ability to cast a provisional ballot to all public elections, including local elections, rather than only in federal elections. The same issues are present in local elections as are in federal elections and so the same remedy should be available in local elections as are available in federal elections. Finally, if the permanent absentee list is not a confidential list, it should be. It is nobody's business who votes by absentee ballot and thus this list should not be susceptible to discovery under a freedom of information law. A vote is a vote whether in person or by absentee ballot.

The primary concern for House Bill 507 is that it could limit the public's ability to question election officials. This concern is primarily centered on its provisions aimed at protecting election officials from harassment, intimidation, or undue influence. These concerns arise from Section 115.638 of the bill, which criminalizes actions such as threatening, harassing, or disseminating personal information about election officials or their families with the intent to intimidate or interfere with their duties. There are already laws on the books that offer protection from harassment and physical harm. Key Concerns:1. Chilling Effect on Public Oversight: We argue that the broad language in Section 115.638 could deter legitimate public scrutiny or criticism of election officials. For example, the prohibition against "conduct reasonably calculated to harass or alarm" could be interpreted to include robust questioning or challenges to election decisions, potentially discouraging civic engagement and accountability efforts.2. Ambiguity in Definitions: Terms such as "harass," "alarm," and "personal information" are not clearly defined, leaving room for subjective interpretation. This ambiguity could lead to inconsistent enforcement and raise concerns about infringing on free speech rights.3. Impact on Transparency: The bill's focus on protecting election officials may inadvertently reduce transparency by making it more difficult for the public to hold officials accountable for errors or misconduct without fear of legal repercussions.4. Potential Overreach: While protecting election officials is important, some worry that these measures might overreach by criminalizing actions that are not genuinely harmful but perceived as critical or confrontational. While the intent of HB 507 is to safeguard election officials from undue harm and intimidation (which is already illegal), this legislation is not only unnecessary but could also silence any criticism or questioning of our election process. Our elections must be open and transparent, and without the ability to question our election officials without the fear of criminal prosecution, it would be impossible for Missourians to have faith in the election process. We, therefore, are opposed to this legislation and urge representatives to reject HB 507.

A putrid dead bird found its way into the bed of my truck, in the parking lot. I got three dozen (mostly anonymous) derisive emails and three dozen (mostly anonymous) phone messages, some of them obscene, after I threatened to follow the state constitution on a particular matter. That was all I experienced; I did not hire private security or seek an escort out of the courthouse, even though I usually left and arrived in the dark. I think the public will come to resent, even more, their company of elected officials living behind a protective wall of metal detectors and special laws.
