I am in favor of passing HB 520. For me as a blind person who does not drive and must plan all of my errands ahead of time, to go to the post office to retrieve undelivered certified mail is a challenge. I am a recipient of the Missouri Blind Pension, which currently has a requirement to send mail communications via certified mail. There have been times when I am at home and when I check my mail there is a slip informing me that I have certified mail. The mail carrier did not even knock on my door. Then I have to plan for and possibly pay to get transportation to the post office. If I am lucky I can get a friend to take me there, but this is not always the case (you can't expect friends to always be available to drive places). If I take an Uber it costs about \$7 each way (that is a lot of money just to pick up one piece of mail). I understand that this is partially the fault of the mail carrier, but if it was not required to send this mail communication certified, then the whole situation would be avoided.
