As a chiropractic physician, I was the only chiropractic provider in the US treating workers onsite at a Ford Motor Company plant. I was the first chiropractic provider to be appointed as an assistant medical director of a major insurance company, (GHP, which became Coventry and is now Aetna). I was the only chiropractor to ever be on staff at the 15,000 members Labor and Health Institutes' medical facility. In addition to private practice, I am a medical fraud investigator working with federal, state and private organizations. My practice is 95% medical referral from medical providers who want their patients to have the most cost-effective care possible. This is all to say that over my 33 years in practice I have seen first-hand, from different aspects, the cost savings that chiropractic management allows. However, the current reimbursement rates and lack of decades long cost of living increase has made providing proper care to those patients impossible. Patients are being referred out of my office for expensive testing and care because I simply cannot afford to treat them at the present reimbursement rates. We are not creating patients. We are not creating office procedures or new office codes. We simply wish to be reimbursed at the same rates as other providers who are delivering the same code. Dear Representative Hausman, I am a practicing Doctor of Chiropractic for over 25 years. Increased access to care will lead to faster service, earlier detection and treatment of illness, which will decrease overall healthcare costs. This will decrease the use and need for medications such as opioids and advanced pain management. I graduated from Logan College of Chiropractic in 2008, after spending over eight years in secondary education. During my training, I learned not only chiropractic care but also physical therapy and rehabilitation—because these treatments are meant to work together. However, I was shocked to learn that insurance companies routinely refuse to reimburse chiropractors for providing physical therapy and rehabilitation services, despite our extensive training in these areas. The research is overwhelmingly clear: a combination of chiropractic care, myofascial release, and physical rehabilitation yields the best outcomes for pain management and musculoskeletal conditions. Yet, chiropractors are forced into an impossible position—either providing essential treatments for free to achieve the best patient outcomes or limiting their care due to unfair reimbursement policies. It is also unreasonable that chiropractors graduate with hundreds of thousands of dollars in student loan debt, only to be told that they can only get paid for a fraction of what they were trained to do. This discrimination not only limits patient access to high-quality, evidence-based care but also discourages future practitioners from entering the field. I strongly urge you to support HB530 to ensure fair reimbursement for licensed healthcare providers, prevent insurance discrimination, and ultimately improve patient care in Missouri. Why is healthcare coverage treated so much differently? This is one of the reasons why Drs are amongst the highest in loan defaults. You, the politicians have fought to keep student loans from being forgiven, but have not taken the necessary steps to passing bills that would make is easier for the Dr to pay back their obligations. Also unfair reimbursement rates hurt the patient more than anyone. Drs are forced to make decisions based more on finances rather than what's in the pts best interest. All we are asking for is to be paid for what the market requires. Getting reimbursed \$14 for nonsensical pre-authorization forms, which actually cost the business 5 times to complete, is an insult to the profession, the Dr. and the patients.

This bill covers what is already in the Public Health Service Act (PHS), which established federal non-discrimination protections for providers (section 2706). It has been in federal law for 14 years and has yet to be enforced. Without this enforcement patients cannot access covered services from the provider of their choice that are licensed and certified in this state. The provisions in Section 2706 of the Public Health Services Act also prohibit discrimination regarding reimbursement based on license type. Providers would be paid the same for the same services within their scope of practice. This bill seeks to reinforce Section 2706 in state law to address insurers' suppressing subscriber utilization by limiting their access to covered services. This concept was important enough 14 years ago for congress to include it in the wording of the Public Health Service Act. However, no one has been willing to enforce the law. With this in both Missouri law and federal law, then it will hopefully end the blatant discrimination in both available services and pay for those services.

The Missouri Psychological Association sees merit in HB530 but would like to suggest a crucial amendment to it to better guarantee that future access to doctoral-level behavioral health services is not harmed. There is a sound argument for uniform reimbursement for identical healthcare services; however, Medicare takes a refined approach by recognizing differences in educational levels among providers. For instance, providers with doctoral degrees, who have invested substantial time in their education and have gained extensive expertise, receive higher reimbursement rates than those with less education.Logically, providers with equivalent education should receive identical reimbursement when delivering similar care for the same types of issues. Under Medicare and Missouri Medicaid, doctoral-level psychologists and psychiatrists are reimbursed equally for similar time-based codes. Similarly, master's-level providers from different fields, such as social work and licensed professional counselors (LPCs), should also receive equitable compensation when they provide comparable services within their professional scope, in comparison to each other.It is essential to refrain from standardizing reimbursement rates between master's and doctoral-level providers, Implementing such a policy would drastically reduce the motivation for healthcare professionals to seek higher education. This could impede the progression of educational levels within our healthcare sectors, which is vital for increasing expertise and enhancing the quality of patient care outcomes. Language that could be used to amend HB530: (2) All health care providers with equivalent educational degrees shall be reimbursed at the same rate for the same service as long as such service is within the provider's scope of practice.
