Thank you for taking my testimony in support of HB 68. As the Executive Director for the Missouri Canoe and Floaters Association, I represent businesses statewide in the floating industry. There is a growing trend to file lawsuits against a business 48-59 months after the alleged accident/injury occurs. This period of time is unreasonable. Accidents and injuries do happen. But so do frivolous lawsuits. When the statute allows five years before filing suit, the defendant has a very limited ability to defend themselves. Even if the business was aware an incident occurred (many are not), security footage is long gone, former employees have moved on and/or changed phone numbers, and people have forgotten any details that would be useful. Ultimately, if a person has a long lasting injury, they'll know within the first 12 months or so of the injury and suits can be filed within the first 24 months. Allowing 60 months to file suit fills our courts with frivolous cases and the backlog hurts those that have truly suffered injuries. Respectfully, Michelle Lambeth
