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This bill by Rep Pollitt has two items that I am in favor of, though one item that I am against, which means I have to be against the bill as written. The change proposed for the "Grade-level equivalence" for DESE for measuring student performance as it matches to their grade level, this is a useful change that would help further determine how students are doing compared to their grade-level work. The other useful change for moving the retired teacher substitute allowance ending this year to the end of 2030, that helps with the substitute teacher shortage with still allowing retired teachers to work in that capacity. The part of this bill that I have an issue with is the removal of the annual increases in minimum teacher salary based on inflation. The work needed to get minimum teacher salary increased up to the amounts allowed in SB727 was a good step forward, though leaving that minimum to slowly worsen in value due to no increases to match inflation would be a disservice to the teachers that would benefit from the salary increases in SB727. Remove this portion of HB712, and I would be for the two beneficial items in there. Have it still remain in the bill, then I must be against it for the issues with teacher salary loss of value that would occur from it still being present.
