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In regards to HB 714 -- VETERANS BIDDING ON STATE CONTRACTS. The United States and Missouri has a duty to care for its veterans because they have defended the nation, and it values. Many state sessions contribute to pass laws to provided the "duty to care". RSMO 36.220---preference for veterans: RSMO 285,250--a private, nonpublic employer may grant preference to a veteran: MO const art IV 19-- veteran's preference, and other similar laws, many of these bills have been sponsor by Honorable Griffith, with that veterans are grateful and owe a forever gratitude for his long efforts. Laws in Missouri has been passed to ensure veterans get an interview. RSMO 36.221 Missouri National Guard members the appointed authority shall offer an interview to every person who is or was a member of the Missouri National Guard or whose name appears on the register of eligibles for the position. This piece of legislation was sponsored by Honorable Parson, again we a grateful and owe a forever gratitude of his efforts. I am in support of this legislation, however, there is no, I repeat no oversight to enforce the needed laws for veterans, without merit system in place, appointed authorities are promoted into these positions, without knowing of basic RSMOs or understanding of the veteran's preference. In this age of instant gratification, most state hiring employees do not honor these laws, and honestly, can care less. Missouri continues to have high veteran suicide rates. Homeless and substance abuse continue to plaque or veteran population. I have personally contacted Jon Sabal for help with misconduct against veterans that resulted in a veteran committing suicide. As Adam Gresham, General Counsel of the Lt Governor's office stated, and I quote "No state or federal agency can tell another agency what to do, it has to be done by a Judge," by then it is too late.
