In July 2023, we submitted license revisions to increase the capacity at 6 of our 29 locations, allowing us to serve a total of 150 more children. To this day, we have not had those approved. DESE is under staffed to m our demands in a timely manner. When our revisions are addressed, there is constant red tape that prohibits us from moving forward, when none of it effects the quality of our care or safety of children nor would it change any part of our operation. In March of 2024, we created a partnership with Brans School District to open an early childhood center. We had an existing license for after school care at this site. We opened this center in November of 2024, but could've opened in August, had we been operating. This was just another expansion of the current license.
